The 2015-16 came to an exciting close with the success of the softball team and the girls track team. The softball team made it to the regional semi-finals in tournament action, falling to the eventual state champions. They set a new school record for wins as they ended the season with a record of 27-3.

In girls track, Kylie Cutlip and Emily Paden were participants in the State Track Meet. Kylie was the state champion in two events. She won the 100 meter hurdles with a time of 14.62 seconds. She set a state track meet record of 42.08 seconds as she also placed first in the 300 meter hurdles. Kylie also placed second in the long jump with a leap of 18 feet, 4 inches. Emily placed third in the state in the pole vault. Her vault of 12 feet was her personal best.
