(suggestions: Star Girl, Where the Red Fern Grows, Percy Jackson)</p>	<p>Sci: Please research and write about the animal of your choice. Include name, classification, habitat, diet, enemies, life cycle/reproduction, future of the species, and anything else special or interesting that you may discover. This obviously could be worked on over multiple days if you chose to do that.</p>	<p>Your 6th teachers will post some optional/extension activities in your Google Classrooms if you want to check out those suggestions!</p>	<p>Math Download a 6th grade math app on your phone and spend 15 to 20 minutes on it a day.</p>
<p>ELA: 6th grade Lang. Arts IXL's- choose any skill and work for 15 mins try to get to 80%</p>	<p>Sci/SS: Please keep a list of your activities and the energy you believe was used during those activities.</p>	<p>Sci: Identify a need for conservation or improved stewardship which could be correcting a problem with pollution or helping to save a species, etc. Outline a plan for what could be done to correct the problem.</p>	<p>Math Go to Google classroom and review your math vocabulary for all of our 5 units. Do the vocabulary practices and try taking a practice test over one unit per day.</p>	<p>Math Go to mathgames.com and work on 6th grade level concepts</p>
<p>ELA: Challenge: Read 2 news articles on the same topic (can you find the similarities/differences)</p>	<p>Sci: Please read a science article or a current events article and summarize it. If you have access to the Google classroom, links will be posted periodically to help you with this activity.</p>	<p>Sci: Identify a need for conservation or improved stewardship which could be correcting a problem with pollution or helping to save a species, etc. Outline a plan for what could be done to correct the problem.</p>	<p>Math There are many math extensions and games that have been previously posted on google classroom. Feel free to go back and do these games/extensions again.</p>	<p>Math Go to google classroom and rewatch some of the posted math videos.</p>

<p>ELA: Write a letter and send it in the mail to someone- If you don't have a stamp send an email to Mrs. W! She probably misses your face.</p>	<p>Sci/SS: Please have a spring adventure outside and take pictures of or draw pictures of different plants and animals that you see. Record any facts that you know from your life science lessons. This can include whether or not they are unicellular or multicellular, eukaryotes or prokaryotes, etc.</p>	<p>Math Continue to work on 6th grade level IxIs in Math that have not yet been assigned. Try to reach an 80% on 1 or 2 per day.</p>	<p>Math If you have your math notebooks at home read through the units and practice the skills again.</p>
