You could read it to your kids one day to tell them about the current Global Pandemic.</p>	<p>Language Arts: Over the course of 3 weeks, as you are watching television or reading a book or article, write down 10 words you hear that you don't know. Define them using a dictionary or online tool. Then, try to use them in your own sentences.</p>
<p>Math: Go to Freckle.com Click on "math" in the bottom left corner Choose "Adaptive Practice" Pick a domain to work in. It will start you off with a pre-test and then you can level up as you work through the problems.</p>	<p>Math: Cook, construct something, or utilize something that involves practice with fractions.</p>	<p>Math: If out and about with family, such as a restaurant or hardware store, look for "bundled deals" where you can identify and compare unit rates.</p>	<p>Math: When playing outside, try and find real examples of reflections, translations and rotations in nature.</p>	<p>Math: Find examples of math used this year on the television and in video games. Make a list of what you find.</p>
