While students are encouraged to use school-provided transportation in traveling to home from school-sponsored extracurricular events in which they participate, the East Guernsey Local School District recognizes that circumstances may exist under which a student's parent/guardian desires that the child ride with a parent/guardian or other responsible adult who is at least 21 years of age. The District treats requests for alternative transportation case-by-case and generally tries to be accommodating. When seeking authorization for alternative transportation from an event, the following information needs to be provided:
