Information Regarding 100% K-12 Remote Learning

- The primary mode of delivery for K-12 remote instruction will be an electronic web-based platform.
- If a student would like to participate in 100% remote learning but does not have access to the internet, the district will address these situations on an individual basis.
- The deadline to apply for remote learning is <u>August 12, 2020.</u>
- Students are required to be enrolled at East Guernsey Local Schools to participate
- Students are required to commit to completing nine weeks of remote learning at a time. Students will have the opportunity to join traditional learning at the end of each nine weeks.
- Each student will be assigned a facilitator to assign work, monitor progress, and answer questions. The facilitators will maintain office hours to answer questions and help troubleshoot issues.
- The workload will be self-paced, but will be monitored weekly for attendance purposes.
- Attendance will be required for remote learners. A minimum of 30 hours of engagement per week will be required by each student. Additional attendance guidelines will be released at a later date. Please understand that there will be rigorous attendance requirements.
- East Guernsey Local Schools will continue to serve students with a disability who wish to participate in remote learning. For students who have an Individualized Education Program (IEP), it is possible that the IEP will need to be amended prior to participation.
- Students wanting to participate in extracurricular activities can do so as long as they meet all school requirements.
